<p>A BSBA candidate can complete the Supply Chain Management and Logistics minor within the 120 credits needed for the BSBA degree if the minor is started early in the candidate's program and planned for properly. However, depending on when the minor is started, the minor can result in a student needing to take up to an additional 18 credits to graduate (138 credits, total) with the minor and this can delay graduation. This is particularly true of management majors. Management Majors who wish to be eligible to earn a Supply Chain management and Logistics Minor must take the courses required for the minor. IN ADDITION to the Restricted Electives (Section V.D. of the BSBA/Management Major Grid Sheet). Courses in the Minor will not double count for the Management Major Restricted Electives section.</p>
